Occupational Health Services:

1. Annual Latex Assessments will be done each year in April.
2. TB Testing will be done every 4 years in April.
3. Physicals will be done every 4 years in your anniversary month, unless you participate in the Healthy Choices Program and receive annual testing.

****ORHC and OSHA require these tests and assessments. Non-compliance will result in disciplinary action!**

4. Treatment for infectious diseases-
 - A. Call your supervisor to report any time off needed for sick days, please specify symptoms.
 - B. Tuberculosis, chicken pox, pertusis, meningococcal meningitis, and strep throat need to be seen in the Occupational Health Clinic.
5. Treatment for injuries-
 - A. Report any and all injuries to your supervisor
 - B. Fill out an incident report immediately
 - C. Call Occupational Health for an appointment for medical treatment
 - D. After hours- Contact the nursing supervisor on duty and see ER for medical treatment
6. Treatment for blood and body fluid exposures-
 - A. Report any and all exposures to your supervisor
 - B. Fill out an incident report immediately
 - C. Contact Infection Control or Occupational Health
 - D. Follow up with Employee Health nurse for labs and counseling
7. Campus Health
 - A. Non work related injuries
 - B. Episodic Illness
 - C. Call x2466 to schedule an appointment
